SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Tarseal ClubSport Advanced Bent Sprint, promoted by the South Taranaki Car Club.

The Event will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport New Zealand Inc National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

This Meeting will be organised under a MotorSport New Zealand **ClubSport Advanced Category Permit**.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION

3.1 Date: Sunday 15th March, 2020

3.2 Venue: Horoi Road, Rawhitiroa, Eltham.

Horoi Road has been used biennially over the past few years and has been used for TARGA.

The sealed event covers 1.9km's and will be quick.

3.3 Classes

The following classes will be observed for placing and club points:

A = 0-1300cc, **B** = 1301-1600cc, **C** = 1601 – 2000cc, **D** = 2001 +, **E** = 4 Wheel Drive,

F = Classic (cars 25 years or older,) **G** = Sports & Racing

Turbo and Rotary equivalence factors will apply. **PLEASE ADVISE THE SECRETARY IF THE CAR IS DUAL ENTERED.** The organisers retain the right to amalgamate, delete or reallocate any class and/or competitor.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://online.motorsport.org.nz>) Any entry will not be deemed valid **until** payment is received. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 5.00pm (normal fee) on **Wednesday 11th March, 2020.**

Entries received after the normal fee-closing date will be subject to a late entry fee.

4.3 Entry Fees:

Entry fee for all classes: **\$90.00** including GST up to closing date, **5.00pm** Wednesday 11th March, 2020.

Late entry fee: **\$130.00** including GST and close at 5.00pm on Friday 13th March, 2020

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

4.4 Number of Starters: The maximum number of starters will be 30. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

LATE ENTRIES will be accepted upon the payment of the **LATE ENTRY FEE.**

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold as a minimum an **M** Grade Competition Licence and current Membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations.
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.

5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current motorsport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINER

7.1 Documentation will take place at the caravan between 8.30am and 9.30am on the day of the event, **if wet**, the Rawhitiroa Hall will be used.

All competitors must report to the meeting Secretary prior to scrutineering and present evidence of their:

- Driver's Civil Licence;
- Driver's Competition Licence;
- Current Club Membership
- Log Book (if applicable)

Failure to provide these documents may result in a fine or exclusion from the event.

All competitors will be required to sign the Event Documentation Signature Sheet.

Vehicle noise must not exceed 95db – the Clerk of Course will be the Judge of Fact.

7.2 **Scrutineering** will take place after attending documentation, each competitor must present their vehicle to the Scrutineer in a clean and tidy condition. A scrutineering audit to Schedule A will be conducted between 8.30am and 9.30am on the day of the event. Documentation and scrutineering must be completed prior to drivers briefing

8. DRIVERS BRIEFING

8.1 **ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY**: A roll call will be held – this will take place at 9.45am at the caravan, or, if wet, in the Rawhitiroa Hall. Any driver who is not in attendance at roll call will be dealt with at the discretion of the Clerk Of the Course.

9. POSTPONEMENT / CANCELLATION / ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS.

9.1 The organisers reserve the right to postpone, cancel or abandon the meeting or part thereof under the following circumstances:

- a) Cancellation of the meeting if less than 12 entries received by **5pm Wednesday 11th, March, 2020**
- b) Postponement if the weather conditions impose or the Steward of the meeting require the meeting to be postponed, delayed or abandoned for reasons of safety.

10. ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY / WITHDRAWAL FROM EVENT PRIOR TO START

10.1 Entrants will be advised if their entry is accepted. If the Secretary is **not notified 24 hours before the event**, then **NO REFUND** will be given. If notified, 80% of the Entry Fee will be returned.

11. PASSENGERS

11.1 Passengers may be carried, at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, provided the car is fitted with the following equipment which must comply with the Safety Schedule contained in the current NZ MotorSport Manual including:

- Approved roll protection (that means Homologated)
- An Approved passenger seat, and
- An Approved passenger safety harness

11.2 All passengers must sign an indemnity form before their run. Minimum age of any passenger is 12 years.

Passengers will be required to wear:

- Protective helmet conforming to MSNZ specifications and standards.
- Clean protective overalls and footwear conforming to MSNZ standards.

11.3 Passengers may be changed between runs at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

12. DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

12.1 Horoi Road is 6.3km's from Eltham. Turn onto King Edward Street (Library Corner) in middle of Eltham. This becomes Rawhitiroa Road. Horoi Road is on your right as you reach the community of Rawhitiroa. If coming from North of Eltham, you have the option of turning left onto Anderson Road just before the Eltham Township. This joins onto Rawhitiroa Road.

13. UNLOADING OF VEHICLES

13.1 All vehicles and trailers are to park in the Paddock on your right just past the Rawhitiroa Hall. Entrance the paddock is on Horoi Road. **NO VEHICLES ARE TO PARK BEFORE THE ENTRANCE OF RAWHITIROA POOL.** The pool may still in use and we are not to hinder their access. Please abide this request.

14. **ALCOHOL** at the venue is **strictly prohibited** while the event is in progress.

15. FOOD

15.1 A BBQ will be available for lunch along with Tea & Coffee and cold drinks as a Fund Raiser for the Rawhitiroa School. Your support would be appreciated. They will be set up at the Rawhitiroa Hall.

16. PRACTICE AND RACING

16.1 Competitors will be split into groups – dual entries will be in separate groups. Practice and racing will be run in these groups. Competitors **MUST PRACTICE/COMPETE IN THE ORDER POSTED** by the Event Secretary and competitors **MUST REMAIN** in this order throughout the meeting, unless exceptional circumstances prevail. Practice will commence at 10.00am. There will be one practice and three official runs. The Clerk of Course retains the right to decrease or increase the number of runs dependent on the road/weather conditions. Practice runs will not be taken as Official Times.

17. STARTING PROCEDURE

17.1 Groups will be called to form **IN THE ORDER GIVEN** and they will make their way from the paddock and line up at the Start Line. Cars will be sent off at intervals. Identification of entrant/vehicle to the Starter is the responsibility of the competitor. Dual entries must also ensure they identify themselves to the Starter.

18. PROCEDURE AT CONCLUSION OF EACH RUN

18.1 Horoi Road loops back onto Rawhitiroa Road, so with luck, racing will continually run without the need for stoppages. Cars will make their way back 1.4km's to the pits.

19. RE-SCRUTINEERING

19.1 Any vehicle involved in a collision or other accident may be required to be re-examined by the Scrutineer prior to continuing with competition, at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

20. RETIREMENTS AND WITHDRAWALS

20.1 These must be notified without delay to the Event Secretary.

21. PROTESTS

21.1 If considered necessary, these should be lodged with the Clerk of Course in accordance with the current NZ MotorSport Manual.

22. VENUE DAMAGE

22.1 In the event of any damage occurring to any part of the venue, **this is to be reported immediately to the Clerk of Course or Event Secretary. Any costs associated with any damage will be incurred by the driver causing the damage.**

23. ACCESS TO PUBLIC

23.1 In the event of members of the public wanting access to the road, please direct them to the Clerk of Course, Caravan, or appropriate meeting official. Access is to be made available after clearance from event officials in line with the safety procedures. **Continued access** to the Swimming Pool will be in place. **The Road Closure Sign will be after** the Entrance to the Pool.

24. RUBBISH

24.1 All competitors, supporters and crew are asked to collect all rubbish and foreign objects in and around the venue on completion of the meeting, and take away with you. We are very fortunate to have the use of the Farmer's paddock. Please don't abuse this.

25. PRIZEGIVING

25.1 Prizegiving will take place in the Rawhitiroa Hall at the conclusion of the meeting, once all areas are tidied and left as they were found.
